Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Vernon Public Schools is proud to announce the implementation of a new, electronic visitor management system that will be implemented in all of our school buildings as of Monday, April 3, 2017. This new system upgrade has been acquired to better protect our children by tracking visitors, contractors, and volunteers who come into our schools.

Upon entering our schools, all visitors will be required to report to the schools main office and present a valid, government issued, photo identification which will be scanned into our electronic visitor management system. A current photo of all visitors will be taken, and a temporary visitors badge will be printed. The system has the ability to provide alerts on individuals who may jeopardize the safety our of schools, including checking the national sexual offender registry.

Checking into the visitor system will not be required for anyone dropping off or picking up an item in the main office. However, if you need to sign out your student during the school day, you will need to present your photo identification so school staff may verify your identity.
